### Introduction

Silver Oaks College of Nursing, established in 2003 is about 28 km from Mohali to village Abhipur, Punjab. It is one of the most prestigious nursing institutions spread over 5 acres of land- established with a vision of enriching the society through knowledge and nursing education.

The college is attached to a 120 bedded multispecialty parent hospital i.e the Silver Oaks Hospital in Phase 9, Mohali, Punjab with super specialty health team providing comprehensive and advanced medical services.

The founder director of this Institution Dr. Akhil Bhargava started the institution in 2003 with a mission and aim to prepare well-qualified nurses to meet the health needs at various levels, raising the health standards of our society along with solving Socio-economic and allied problems.

To start with, the college had B.Sc. Nursing (4 years) Degree course in 2003 after approval by the Government of Punjab, Punjab Nurses Registration Council and Indian Nursing Council with an intake of 50 students. This degree course is affiliated with BFUHS, Faridkot. In 2005, Diploma in Nursing and Midwifery was started with an intake of 40 students. Subsequently in the year 2008, Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing course was introduced to facilitate the nurses to continue their professional learning. To prepare nurses at the grass root level ANM course was started in 2011. From 2012, students will be admitted to post graduate programs.

### **Admission Process**

#### GNM COURSE

- The candidate should have passed 10+2 with any stream. Preference shall be given to the candidates with the science stream.
- Candidate must have completed the age of 17 years on or before 31st Dec., of the corresponding year.
- Selection of the candidate shall be on merit.

#### **B.Sc NURSING**

- The candidate should have passed 10+1 and 10+2 examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English
- Candidate must have completed the age of 17 years on or before 31st Dec., of the corresponding year. All candidates should apply for admission to B.F.U.H.S. who fulfills the eligibility criteria and other conditions. The Selection of candidates will be made by the Central Admission Committee among the candidates who have qualified the PPMET

### POST BASIC B.Sc. NURSING

- The candidate should have passed GNM Examination after 10+2.
- The candidate should be registered with the state council.
- Selection of the candidates shall be made as per the norms set by the university from time to time.
